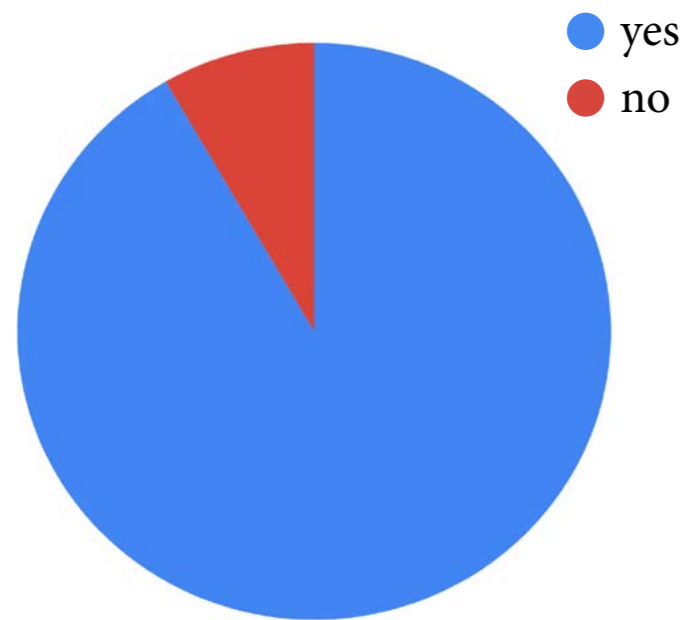


Future or Fiction

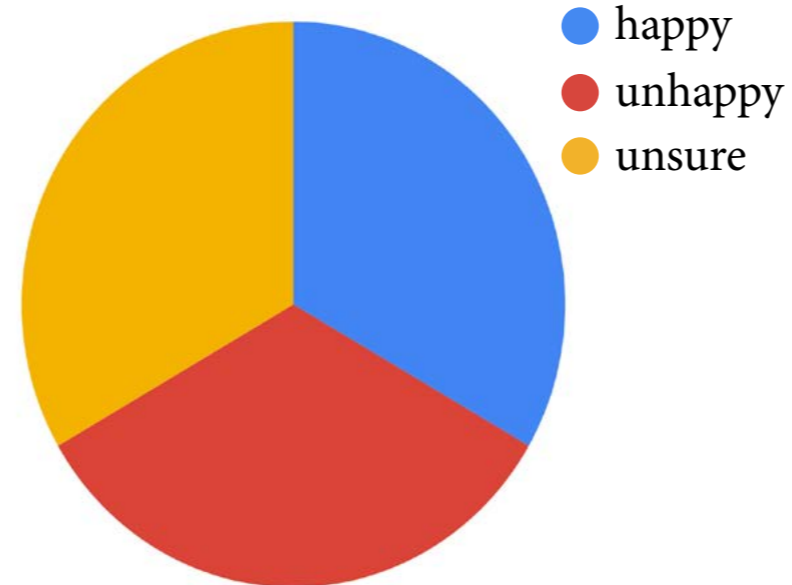

In 2018, about 80% of college students changed their major. The likelihood of students following through with their high school plans is slim.

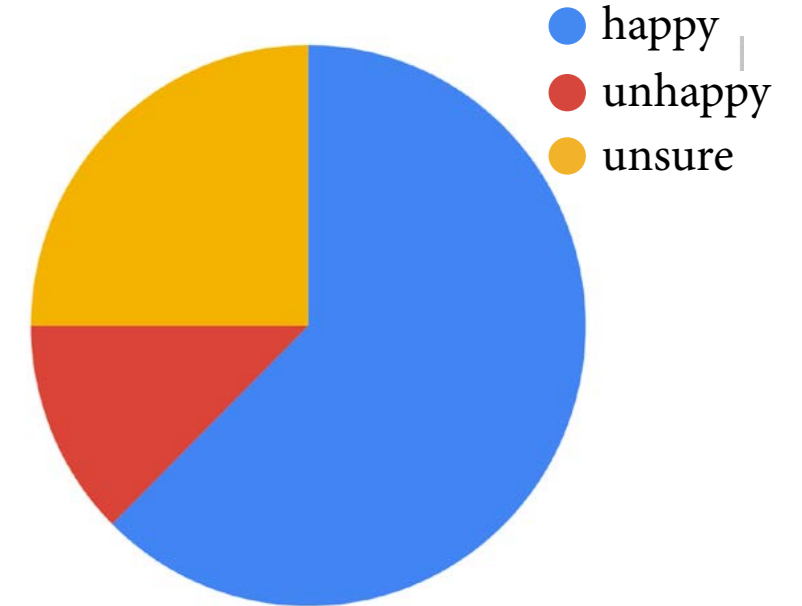
Fourteen Alma seniors were interviewed. The results are indicated in the graphs below:
